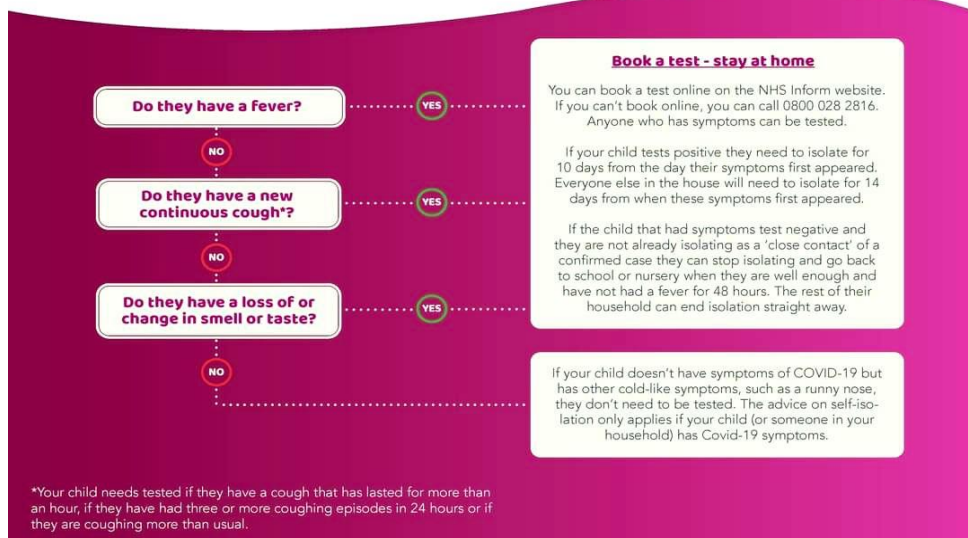
Remaining Vigilant
